AirVenture Museum Receives Equipment Donation

Portland, Oregon - Flightcom Corporation donates 30 passive Denali® headsets to the flight simulation center at the EAA AirVenture Museum in Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

The program teams students in groups of four to take on “Operation Aviation”, a 3-hour training, planning and simulated flying rescue mission. Using Microsoft Flight Simulator aircraft in mock cockpits, the teams “fly” to Los Angeles, where a massive earthquake has destroyed much of the city. The museum expects to have up to 1,400 school age students participate in the 50 scheduled missions this year. The center is also used by adult groups for team-building and communications activities.



Lisa Reisman, Marketing Communications Manager for Flightcom commented, “In deciding which headset would be best for this application, we took into consideration

that the headsets would receive a lot of handling and would need to fit a wide range of head sizes comfortably. Denali is perfect because of the low side-force “fitting memory” that relaxes into position without clamping. And the lightweight composite headband material is reinforced with nylon fiber for extra strength. I expect that the experimenting, young pilots-to-be will give these headsets a real work-out.”
